2. What's happening in Your Area

Vehicle crime – Just two reports across St Marys Ward during March. Number plates were stolen from a secure and unattended BMW in the Wilbert Lane area. Another vehicle which was parked secure and unattended had its side window smashed in order to gain entry and remove a disc cutting saw from within. Meanwhile across Minster & Woodmansey Ward there were several reports made, five of which were damage related ranging from windscreens been deliberately attacked resulting in the successful arrest of one male after a police vehicle was also targeted. A vehicle that was parked and secure in the area of Highgate on the roadside had both front and rear number plates stolen.

<u>Burglary reports</u> – There have been three reports of residential burglaries in the Minster and Woodmansey area last month, one of which involves unknown person enter a property via an upstairs window and steal two boxes of medication before egressing as per entry method. Another property in Woodmansey was entered by smashing the rear kitchen window and once inside steal property from within before making off. A further five business burglaries were reported of which enquiries are ongoing. There was one report of business burglary across St Marys Ward last month.

Shop theft – There were high reports of shop thefts across St Marys Ward last month one of which resulted in the successful arrest of a female. A further three reports were made across Minster and Woodmansey Ward.

had left windows or a door open.

- Hide vehicle keys and don't leave valuables on display
- If you have a garage, use it to keep your car secure
